# Welcome to the Kaikoura District

*You can help our local community to protect the amazing environment by following these guidelines and map.*

## 1. Stay at a campground

Contact the i-SITE for details of campgrounds throughout the District (Ph: 03 319 5641).

## 2. Use one of Kaikoura's 7 public toilet facilities

Faecal waste can be a serious environmental & public health issue - consider the consequences of your actions and travel to a public toilet/dump station.

## 3. Recycle carefully and remove waste

Assist us to achieve zero waste to landfill by recycling. Leave your picnic site cleaner than when you arrived. Drop recyclable items (at no charge) and waste (for a small fee) to The Resource Recovery Centre (Ph: 03 319 7148).

## 4. Observe the independent travellers map (overleaf)

Independent overnight stays on Council Reserves are prohibited. Please observe the map on the back, highlighting the urban area not suitable for sleeping in vehicles/camping overnight.
