



In 1996 I ventured to the South Island in search of uncrowded surf breaks and the fresh dry snow of the Southern Alps.

Once finishing my studies of Adventure Tourism based in the Tongariro National Park, I began looking for opportunities to start my own sea kayaking operation. After reading an article in New Zealand Surfer magazine on Kaikōura, I decided that this coastline could provide the opportunity to create Kaikōura Kayaks. Tourism was present in the small seaside village with Whale Watch Kaikōura, Dolphin Encounter, Seal Swim, Wings Over Whales and Kaikōura Helicopters operating successfully but no kayaking operators.

Peddling my mountain bike over the Kaikōura Peninsula, I was instantly excited, founding an abundance of marine life, breath-taking scenery, and a dramatic coastline. I knew Kaikōura was the place!

In 1998 it finally became a reality. After two years of planning, saving, obtaining a marine mammal Seal watching permit, building up a fleet of kayaks and purchasing a land rover Kaikōura had its first licensed kayak operator.

Kaikōura Kayaks pioneered the half day guided sea kayaking tour in New Zealand, followed by the family friendly tour with 100% guaranteed Fur Seal sightings, chance encounters of Dusky Dolphins and Blue Penguins. We are now very fortunate to have a marine mammal viewing permit for Seals, dolphins & Whales.

26 years later Kaikōura Kayaks has successfully show cased Kaikōura leaving lifetime memories to many visitors. A family operated business with my wife Kim and daughters, together with a strong and passionate crew.
